

ILLNESS POLICY

In order to stay healthy in our space, we urge our staff, students, and guardians to stay home if you are sick!

You are the best judge of your child's health, and we trust that you will not bring your child into the space if they are ill. However, if the playcare staff determines your child is exhibiting symptoms that may indicate that your child is sick, we will ask that you come to pick up your child within an hour. Your child will be isolated from the rest of the children until you arrive.

If your child is exhibiting any of the following signs/symptoms, we will ask that your child must go home:

- Fever of 100 degrees or higher
- Inflammation of the eyes (excessive redness, glass or discharge)
- Vomiting/diarrhea
- Communicable disease as defined by the Department of Health Services/ Center for Disease Control
- Unknown rash
- Excessive nasal discharge, especially if yellow or greenish
- Excessive crying due to unknown causes and/or pain

If your child is sent home due to illness, they are unable to return to the Blush x Hopscotch space until they are free from symptoms for 24 hours without the use of medication. This will allow your child ample time to recover and stop the spread of illness to the other children and/or staff.
